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CONTEXT

The World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) is the intergovernmental organisation responsible for improving animal health and welfare worldwide. The WOAH develops standards that its 182 Members can use to protect themselves from incursions of diseases or pathogens while avoiding unjustified trade barriers. The World Trade Organization (WTO) recognises the WOAH as the international reference organisation for ensuring the sanitary safety of international trade of animals and animal products. **e-CERISE has been designed to facilitate the implementation of WOAH standards. This module will provide you with a generic introduction of the WOAH.**

PROGRAMME

Main objective:

This module is generic and an introduction to the other e-Cerise modules which are of a more technical nature. It just aims at presentation WOAH **organisation, mandate, missions**, and some of its **activities**.
