E-CERISE (Online – Continuing Education for VeteRInary Services)





E-CERISE is an e-learning course for official veterinarians, granting an inter veterinary school diploma. Based directly on WOAH standards and recommendations, the course is made up of 10 mandatory modules. In parallel to the online modules, students develop, under the supervision of a designated tutor, a personal project linked to their country's WOAH PVS Pathway report, followed by an oral presentation at the end of the course.

- All modules are available independently "à la carte"
- A residential session in France for participants could be proposed in that framework

INDEPENDENT MODULES



We offer the possibility of exploring several topical subjects with independent online modules developed by international experts. The format consists of a few days of teaching (one to three days). These modules give participants the chance to acquire knowledge in specific subjects such as antimicrobial resistance, food safety, crisis management or the One Health approach. Each online training course is available for a period of one month and is completed by a webinar.

RESIDENTIAL COURSES





Residential courses are face-to-face thematic training courses in the veterinary domain. Based directly on WOAH standards and recommendations, residential courses are aimed at both official veterinarians and managers from the private sector (animal production, pharmaceutical and agro-industry). Built on a "One Health" approach, courses provide participants with a wide range of general and technical knowledge. Participants will benefit from study trips to Paris, Brussels or Geneva, as well as field trips to face with real-life case studies.

MASTER ONE HEALTH





The Master One Health: Managing Health of Populations covers a broad range of One Health topics, and calls for interdisciplinary and intersectoral action in the management of public health problems. This face-to-face training course includes a common core curriculum and two specialisation options in risk assessment and risk management. The course is targeted both at students and at working professionals (official veterinarians, physicians, health managers, economists...). Career opportunities include all types of health professionals involved in risk assessment or risk management.
