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## TARGET AUDIENCE

Official veterinarians :

- from countries that have committed to the WOAHP PVS Pathway
- wishing to acquire additional skills and to progress in their functions and responsibilities

An advanced degree in the veterinary sciences and 3 to 5 years of relevant professional work experience are required.

## TRAINING OBJECTIVES

At the end of the course, the participants :

- Will have the knowledge and skills necessary to actively participate in the design, implementation, evaluation, and coordination of veterinary public-health policies
- will understand how to implement WOAHP recommendations for their home countries

The content of the course will be adapted, on a case-by-case basis, to the local situation for each participant's home country and to the strategy designed for that country as a result of the PVS Gap Analysis (Evaluation of Performance of Veterinary Services).

## PEDAGOGICAL METHODS

e-learning platform (PowerPoint with comments, interviews, videos, webinars...)

A personal project whose theme is defined by the participant and his/her administration: this will be discussed during the face-to-face session and followed up by a tutor.

## CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Validation of training modules.

Validation of the personal project: written report and oral restitution.

## DURATION

Three non-consecutive one-day sessions per month for 10 months (workload of 230-250 hours over the year).

A personal project requiring around ten days of mobilization.

## LOCATION

Online courses + Face-to-face session in November, at ENSV-FVI, VETAGROSUP, MARCY L'ÉTOILE (LYON, France)

## TUITION FEES

8000 € (face-to-face session included) - Need-based scholarships are available, please contact us if you want to apply.
