

2025 INTERNATIONAL TRAINING CATALOGUE

DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW AND TRAINING OFFER



ENSV-FVI's International Training department was created in November 2020. All the department's activities contribute to the implementation of WOAHP standards and recommendations, in line with the ENSV-FVI mandate as WOAHP Collaborating Centre for the training of Official Veterinarians.

Three types of training have been developed :

- 1- e-CERISE** : Distant learning course leading to a diploma (Online - Continuing Education for VeterInary Services) ;
- 2- Residential courses** : face-to-face training courses including lectures, case studies, field trips and study visits to Paris, Brussels or Geneva ;
- 3- Independent e-Modules** : give participants the chance to acquire knowledge in specific subjects such as Autogenous vaccines, Methodology of Inspection or Fight against antimicrobial resistance



E-CERISE is an e-learning course granting an inter veterinary school diploma. Based directly on WOAHP standards and recommendations, the course is made up of 10 e-modules.



TRAINING OBJECTIVES : Obtain the knowledge and skills necessary to actively participate in the design, implementation, evaluation, and coordination of veterinary public-health policies ; understand how to implement WOAHP recommendations for their home countries.

TARGET AUDIENCE : Official Veterinarians from countries that have committed to the WOAHP PVS Pathway wishing to acquire additional skills and to progress in their functions and responsibilities. An advanced degree in the veterinary sciences and 3 to 5 years of relevant professional work experience are required.

PEDAGOGICAL METHODS : e-learning platform with pedagogical content, interviews, webinars...). In parallel to the online modules, students develop, under the supervision of a designated tutor, a personal project linked to their country's WOAHP PVS Pathway report, followed by an oral presentation at the end of the course.

DURATION : Three non-consecutive one-day sessions per month (workload of 230-250 hours over the year). A personal project requiring around ten days of mobilization.

POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMME : Diploma of continuing education in Veterinary Public Health Policy and Quality of Veterinary Services.

TUITION FEES : 8 000€

Residential courses are face-to-face thematic training courses in the veterinary domain based directly on WOAAH standards and recommendations.



TRAINING OBJECTIVES : Built on a "One Health" approach, courses provide participants with a wide range of general and technical knowledge on global issues and topical subjects such as animal health crisis management, antibiotic resistance, health surveillance and epizootic prevention.

TARGET AUDIENCE : Veterinary officers and staff of veterinary institutions.

PEDAGOGICAL METHODS : Presentations, practical training based on case studies, group works, sharing of experiences and field visits.

DURATION : Around 15 days at ENSV-FVI in Marcy l'Etoile, places of interest related to the subject of the course and finally in Paris

DELIVERED CERTIFICATE : Certificate of attendance

TUITION FEES : 6 000€
do not cover living expenses in Lyon, travel to & from France, insurance coverage or visa fees.
Need-based scholarships are available

TRAINING OBJECTIVES : These modules give participants the chance to acquire knowledge in specific subjects such as autogeneous vaccins, fight against antimicrobial resistance or methodology of inspection

TARGET AUDIENCE : Official Veterinarians and any actor in the field of veterinary Public Health

PEDAGOGICAL METHODS : The format consists of a day and a half of teaching on ENSV-FVI's e-learning platform and is completed by a webinar

DURATION : a day and a half of teaching available for a period of 3 weeks

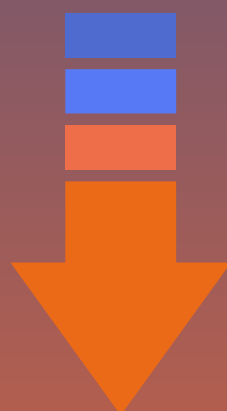
DELIVERED CERTIFICATE : Certificate of attendance
